Project: Repairs to Bathroom at Sidney R. Yates Building

Location: Washington, DC

Rife International was selected to provide custom repairs to approximately 70 restroom stall door hinges and pivot pins at the Historic Sidney Yates Building in Washington D.C. Rife removed and replaced hinges and pins in 66 restroom partition doors.

The original units were approximately 25 years old and were a risk to injury. Our team worked carefully and diligently to complete the repairs throughout the building including all five floors and the basement level. There also were 36 locations where laminated doors needed several repairs. Rife International repaired the laminated door parts for safety reasons.

Additionally, we inspected and noted located defects in the bathrooms which were addressed to the client such as damaged locks and missing door stops.

Rife provided solutions that will maintain the structural integrity of the stall units while providing overall safety to the building occupants.
