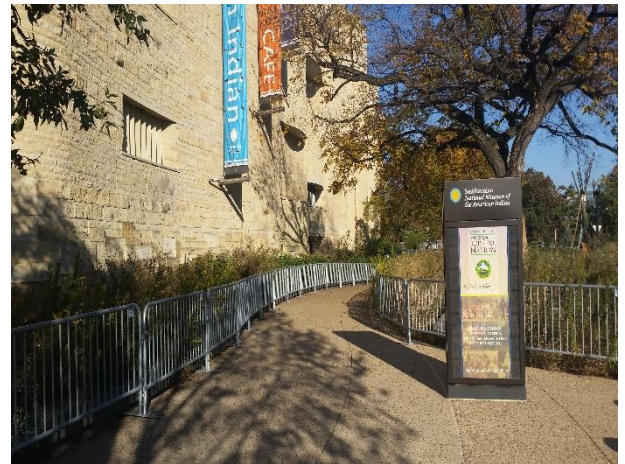
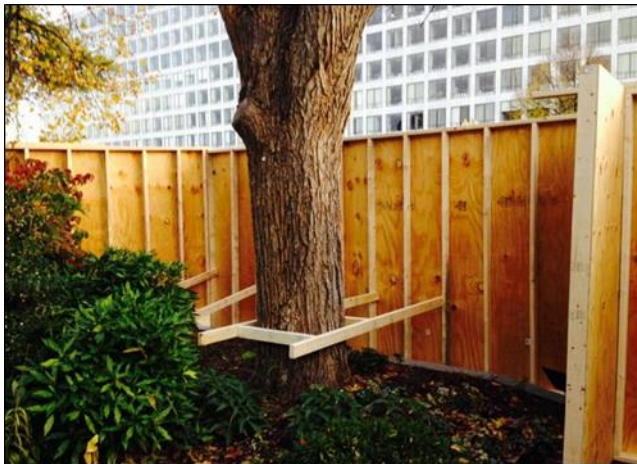

Rife International, serving as a General Contractor to the Smithsonian Institution (SI), was selected to furnish all supervision, labor, material, and equipment needed to install temporary fences for the HBO Concert for Valor, which took place at the National Mall on November 11th, 2014.

Rife was responsible for the installation and break-down of 2,610 linear feet (348 units) of 90" x 42" galvanized barricades and temporary fence panels along the designated event space.

Rife also created custom wood fences which provided protection for foreign indigenous plants and a profound underground irrigation system. The Concert for Valor was attended by millions of people, including veterans, active duty service

members and their families with the goal of raising awareness for veterans service organizations dedicated to education, wellness, reemployment, and reintegration.
